On 17th September 2025, the grounds of Chitkara University, Punjab bore witness to an act both simple and enduring. In collaboration with the **National Service Scheme, Chitkara Business School, the Department of Computer Applications, and the Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering**, and in association with **Rajindra Hospital, Patiala**, a **blood donation camp** was organized under the banner of **Raktdan Amrit Mahotsav 2.0**.

The morning unfolded without urgency. Volunteers arrived early, arranging tables and chairs, preparing spaces where courage would sit calmly for a while. Students gathered, some certain, others thoughtful, all aware of the choice before them. There was no spectacle in the act of donation. Each donor stepped forward in their own time, sleeves rolled back, eyes steady, offering something that could never be replaced once given.

Inside the hall, silence was broken only by soft instructions and the hum of movement. Outside, the day continued as days do, unaware that lives elsewhere were being quietly safeguarded. The blood collected carried no names, no faces, only the promise of survival for someone unknown. In that anonymity lay its strength.

By the close of the camp, 200 **units of blood** had been donated. The number stood firm, measured and clear, yet it held stories beyond counting. Each unit spoke of trust, in medicine, in humanity, in the belief that one person's strength could steady another's fragile moment. Fear gave way to resolve. Discomfort passed. What remained was a shared understanding of responsibility.

The day did not ask for applause. It offered something better: the assurance that ordinary people, when brought together with purpose, can shape outcomes that last

far beyond the hour. As the volunteers dispersed and the campus returned to its rhythm, the gift endured, flowing onward, carrying hope exactly where it was needed.
