# SNEHIL PRYAS-HELPING UNDERPRIVILEGED IN THE HOUR OF NEED

**"Comfort in a classroom isn't a luxury, it's a quiet foundation for learning to begin."**

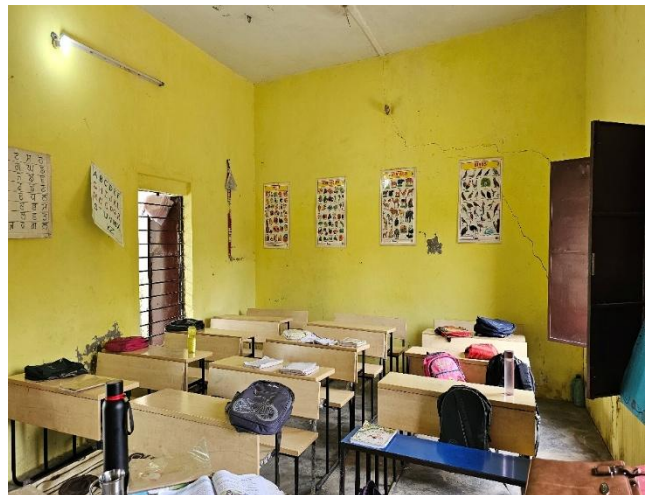
There are places where care is measured in small, steady acts, where impact is not loud, but lasting. On 17<sup>th</sup> July 2025, the **National Service Scheme, Chitkara University, Punjab** stepped into such spaces through **Snehil Pryas**, reaching out to the schools of **Kalomajra and Ramnagar** with a simple intention: to offer what was needed, at the hour it was needed most.

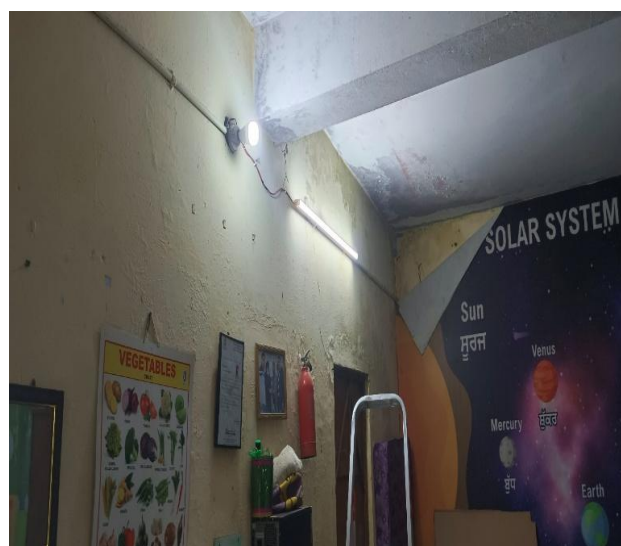
At **Kalomajra**, **five fans and five tube lights** were donated, essentials that ease the day's harshness and help restore focus within the classroom. There was no ceremony, just the plainness of purpose. Alongside them, students received **stationery items**, tools for writing, sketching, and imagining. In another direction, **Ramnagar School** received **ten fans**, carried in by hands that understood how a shift in temperature could change a day for both teacher and child.

These offerings were not about filling space. They were about filling absence. A functioning fan, a working light, a fresh notebook; each one quietly returns something that should have always been there. These are small restorations, but they speak with a kind of clarity.

The volunteers who came with them were thoughtful in their steps. They were not guests, they arrived like those who already belonged, who saw these schools not as strangers but as part of the same unfolding fabric. Their presence was rooted in something steady, an understanding that growth must stretch beyond the campus boundary, into the lives that stand beside it.

Chitkara University continues to move forward with this understanding, holding fast to a belief that education is inseparable from empathy. Through Snehil Pryas, it reminds us that support need not arrive dressed in grandeur. Sometimes, it comes with a fan that spins, a pen that works, and a page that waits. And in this exchange, something essential begins to take root: the assurance that someone looked, understood, and chose to act.









## SNEHIL PRYAS-HELPING UNDERPRIVILEGED IN THE HOUR OF NEED

There are gestures that do not seek attention yet leave a lasting mark. On this occasion, the National Service Scheme, Chitkara University, Punjab carried forward its commitment to the adopted villages through a stationery distribution drive, reaffirming that meaningful change often begins with the simplest acts of care.

## SNEHIL PRYAS-HELPING UNDERPRIVILEGED IN THE HOUR OF NEED

19<sup>th</sup> May 2026

As part of its ongoing commitment to community welfare and sustainable rural development, the National Service Scheme (NSS), Chitkara University, Punjab undertook the donation of a Water Cooler equipped with an RO Purification System to the Community Health Centre at Village Kalomajra. The initiative was aimed at improving access to safe and hygienic drinking water for patients, attendants, healthcare professionals, and members of the local community visiting the health centre.

Recognizing the importance of clean drinking water in healthcare settings, the installation of the RO-enabled water cooler addressed a vital infrastructural need. The facility is expected to enhance the overall environment of the health centre by ensuring the continuous availability of purified drinking water, thereby contributing to the comfort, health, and well-being of all beneficiaries.

The activity reflects the National Service Scheme's commitment to identifying and addressing the essential needs of the communities it serves through meaningful and sustainable interventions. Rather than being a one-time contribution, the installation of the water cooler represents a long-term resource that will continue to benefit the community on a daily basis.

The initiative was carried out with the active participation of NSS volunteers, whose dedicated efforts demonstrated the values of service, social responsibility, and community engagement. Their involvement reinforced the university's vision of extending learning beyond the classroom by encouraging students to contribute positively to society through impactful outreach activities. Through this initiative, Chitkara University, Punjab continues to strengthen its partnership with the adopted villages and promote inclusive community development. The donation of the Water Cooler with an RO Purification System stands as a meaningful step towards enhancing public welfare, reaffirming the University's commitment to creating lasting social impact through service-oriented initiatives.
