





Dr. Abhishek introduced the audience to the new trends in Dual Energy Computed Tomography and its growing application in the imaging. Dual-Energy Computed Tomography. Dualenergy CT is a new technique in which patients are imaged using two different x-ray energy spectra, a high-energy spectrum around 140 kV and a lower-energy spectrum at 80 or 100 kV. This technique is only possible on CT scanners constructed for this purpose, called dualenergy CT scanners. It is gaining popularity as Dual-energy computed tomography (DECT) yields precise anatomic and functional images by exploiting differences in the interactions of high- and low-energy photon spectra with different tissues' and materials' atomic components



to more precisely differentiate the chemistry of tissues and disease processes than is possible with traditional single-energy CT scan acquisitions.

Following the enlightening session, the event proceeded with the fun session full of riddles related to anatomical parts and audience had to guess the answer. Taking the audience back to the era, when W.C. Roentgen discovered the X-Rays, the students of B.Sc MRIT put a skit which showed the walk from the history of X-Rays to the present scenario, Where radiology department is the soul of the healthcare. #### **Description of Event:**

Department of Allied Health Sciences, Chitkara School of Health Sciences, Chitkara University, Punjab organized a Radio Talk Episode-2 under the series of Baatien Sehat Ki on the theme "Important Facts about Daily Consumption of Pulses and Spices". As our target audience were the nearby villages therefore, preferred language was Hindi. Faculty and students participated in the event- Dr. Smita Singh, Mr. Vansh, Ms. Princy, Ms. Priya and Ms. Vidhi from B.Sc Nutrition and Dietetics presented the radio talk. Dr. Smita Singh was the expert for the event. Our topic for the radio talk i.e. Important Facts about Daily Consumption of Pulses and Spices was explained in two parts. First part discussed about the anti-nutrients in pulses by Ms. Princy. She briefly explained about the presence of anti-nutritive factors in pulses, such as lathyrogens, trypsin inhibitor and saponins and the necessary processing steps (steaming, roasting, fermentation, soaking, germination; etc.) to be taken before and during their cooking in order to suppress their harmful activity for maximum utilization of the nutrients present in the pulses upon consumption. Importance of spices was explained by Ms. Vidhi and Ms. Priya. They talked about variety of spices, such as, cumin, cinnamon, asafoetida, black pepper, garlic, ginger, turmeric, ajwain, thyme and many other that are commonly used in the household in the food preparations. They explained about the components of spices responsible their phenomenal characteristics and hence, spices should be used and consumed at a certain proportion. They also highlighted that cooking of spices on high heat which leads to their burning deteriorate their functional properties. Therefore, spices must be cooked on low to medium heat. The session was concluded by Dr. Smita Singh, as an expert she expressed her vision on important constituents of pulses and spices. The various causes associated with the consumption of under processed pulses which makes their nutrients unavailable in the human body upon consumption and hence, they should be properly preprocessed prior to cooking. Also, she summarized the significance of regular consumption of spices on human health.






