The MoUs signed by Chitkara University span a wide range of areas, reflecting the university's multidisciplinary approach to education and research. Some of the key areas of collaboration include:

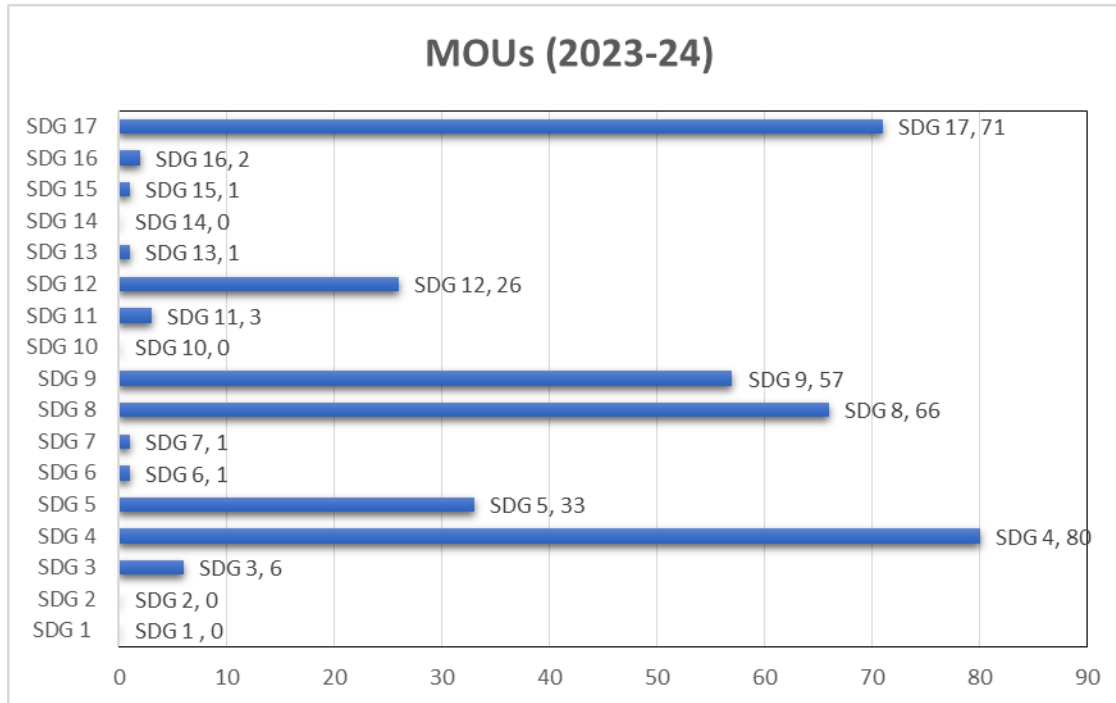
