

Outcomes:



Outcomes:



- To celebrate *International Mother Language Day* by providing a space for native languages to be honoured and expressed.
- To encourage students to embrace and share their linguistic heritage.
- To foster unity through the shared experience of diverse linguistic traditions.

On the 21st of February 2025, the air at Chitkara University, Punjab, was thick with nostalgia and reverence. Voices rose and fell, some cradling the echoes of childhood, others bearing the weight of forgotten histories. The Office of Student Affairs opened a door, not to competition, not to spectacle, but to something far older and deeper. International Mother Language Day was not an event; it was a return.

A hush settled over the gathering as students stepped forward, each carrying the soul of their language in the curve of their vowels, in the weight of their consonants. Words, some as soft as the lullabies whispered by grandmothers, others as fierce as battle cries once carried through the ages, filled the room. **Ghazals** flowed like rivers, folk tales stretched their arms across generations, and poetry stood unshaken, refusing to fade.

No names were announced. No trophies gleamed under the lights. Yet, in that moment, each voice found a home, each word found a listener. A Punjabi *boli*, a Bengali verse, a Tamil hymn, each language carved its own space, unapologetic in its presence, untamed in its rhythm. does not survive in ink alone. It lives in the way a mother calls her child home, in the lull of evening prayers, in the first words a child utters without fear.

A student stood at the podium, voice trembling but eyes alight. He spoke not in the language of textbooks or business meetings but in the language his father once spoke to the stars. No one in the room understood every word, but understanding was never the point. The weight of heritage hung in the air, woven into the cadence of each syllable, felt in the way silence held its breath between lines.

As the evening sun cast long shadows, the gathering came to a quite close. No applause broke the moment. Instead, there was a stillness, the kind that settles after something sacred has been witnessed. Some walked away with verses humming in their minds, others with a new longing to trace their roots back through words unspoken for too long. But all carried the knowledge that language is more than just a tool. It is a memory. It is home.

Outcomes:


- A deeply moving event where students connect with their roots through poetry and storytelling.



The dancers did not seek to impress, they arrived prepared, grounded in practice, and open to the moment. Every movement marked presence. Every turn, pause, and lift carried the weight of attention.

Mr. Balkar Sidhu and Dr. Samira Koser, invited as guests and judges, stood not apart from the event, but within its energy. Their observation was steady, their words thoughtful. They responded not to perfection, but to the honesty each dancer





brought to the floor. Their reflections reminded the gathering that dance, at its core, is less about performance and more about how one chooses to show up, in movement, in stillness, in effort.

Following the performances, **Akanksha Sharma** conducted a workshop that invited students to engage more deeply with their own physical awareness. Without mirrors, without spotlight, participants moved to the internal beat, their own timing, their own breath. In that hour, dance returned to its earliest form: connection, presence, attention to the now.

World Dance Day at Chitkara was not marked by excess or display. It lived in the details, the lifted chin before a leap, the hush before music resumed, the shared silence that followed a well-finished sequence. These were not fleeting moments. They were held. Not for spectacle, but for meaning.

Through this celebration, **Chitkara University** reaffirmed its commitment to cultivating talent and intention. It continues to create space where students can meet their own potential with clarity, guided by practice, and supported by a community that recognises depth when it stands before them, without noise, without claim, but fully present.

Outcomes: -

- 1. The event featured energetic performances across genres and styles, celebrating global cultures and traditions through rhythm and movement.
- 2. Participation in group and solo performances enhanced student collaboration, confidence, and stage presence.
- 3. The celebration created a lively and inclusive atmosphere, drawing enthusiastic participation from students and faculty alike.





"When access becomes equal and voices unmuted, the future hums a fairer tune."

On 17 May 2025, the National Service Scheme of Chitkara University, Punjab observed World Telecommunication and Information Society Day through a focused radio talk show that addressed a question of enduring relevance: Why does gender equality in digital transformation matter?

Broadcasted live on **107.8 FM Radio Chitkara**, the session was anchored by **Aadarsh**, whose composed presence helped set the tone for an honest and thoughtful discussion. The panel brought together voices from key intersections of media, technology, and policy, **Dr. Ashutosh Mishra**, Dean, Mass Communication; **Dr. Pawan Mehta**, Director, Technology Procurement Group; and **Mr. Tanuj Kumar**, Director, Information Technology, Chitkara University, Punjab.

The dialogue opened with a look at communication before digitization, when reach was restricted by both tools and societal structure. The conversation gradually





moved into the present, where information travels faster but still fails to land equally. The panelists traced the paths women and marginalised groups continue to navigate in tech-driven spaces, where silence often exists not from lack of thought, but from lack of access.

Listeners were invited not into a lecture, but into a dialogue shaped by clarity and lived context. The guests addressed the infrastructural gaps, the policy implications, and the responsibilities of institutions. They spoke not just of inclusion, but of an agency, of the importance of designing systems where no one needs permission to participate.

As the session ended, it left behind a steady thought: progress is not defined by tools alone. It is carried by who gets to use them, how freely they can speak, and whether their presence shifts the environment for the better.

With this observance, **Chitkara University** demonstrated its continued investment in conversations that do not end at awareness. The radio waves carried more than voices; they carried intent. And through that intent, the university reaffirmed a culture of equality rooted in knowledge, clarity, and the right to be heard.

Outcomes: -

- 1. Thought-provoking sessions and student-led discussions shed light on the barriers women face in the digital world, encouraging solutions for inclusivity.
- 2. Talks by women in technology and communication industries inspired students and celebrated the contributions of female leaders in the digital space.
- 3. Students were motivated to design inclusive digital projects and adopt gender-sensitive approaches in tech development and communication practices.
