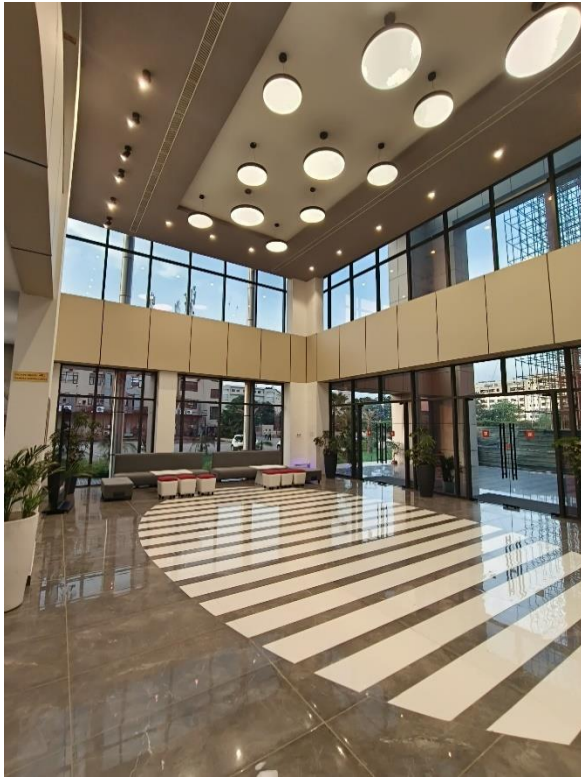
5. Green Building
