particularly those originating from Southeast Asian countries, which have been linked to organized cyber crimes and human trafficking.

Exposing the Reality of Cyber Slavery

The broadcast highlighted the tactics used by cybercriminals to lure unsuspecting job seekers with promises of lucrative overseas employment. These scams often involve offers of high salaries, luxurious accommodations, and other benefits but lead victims into a harrowing reality.

- Many individuals accepting such offers find themselves trafficked to foreign countries.
- Victims are held in inhumane conditions, deprived of their freedom, and coerced into committing cybercrimes.
- Escape or repatriation is nearly impossible without external intervention.

Call for Caution and Action

Radio Chitkara urged listeners to exercise vigilance when receiving unsolicited job offers and provided actionable advice to safeguard against these scams:





- Verify authenticity through government-approved agencies.
- Avoid upfront payments or sharing sensitive personal information.
- Be wary of suspicious recruiters promising visas or travel documents without following legal procedures.

The program emphasized the importance of reporting fraudulent activities to the authorities. Listeners were encouraged to use the dedicated cybercrime helpline 1930 or visit cybercrime.gov.in to report suspicious emails, calls, or messages.

Real-Life Stories and Expert Insights

The broadcast featured real-life accounts of individuals who had fallen prey to such scams, underscoring the urgency of awareness. Expert interviews and official opinions provided further insights on identifying red flags, such as:



- Emails from unverified addresses.
- Demands for personal details or upfront payments.
- Promises bypassing standard legal processes.

Interactive sessions invited listeners to share their

experiences and ask questions, fostering community dialogue and a collective sense of responsibility.
