About the Activity

In continuation of Chitkara University's efforts toward rural development and sustainable living, the Office of Administration, in collaboration with the Centre of Excellence for Sustainability, organized a Clean Village Initiative and Donation Drive at Village Nadiali. The initiative aimed to promote cleanliness, reduce single-use plastic, and support the village's vision of becoming a "Plastic-Free Community."

About the Donation

Under this initiative, the following items were distributed and installed across the village:

- 250 small dustbins for village families.
- 250 cloth bags to encourage reduced plastic usage.
- 4 large bins (2 for *dry waste* and 2 for *wet waste*) strategically placed in and around the village.

These items were distributed to families to promote household waste segregation and sustainable disposal practices. Larger bins were installed at key points to ensure proper waste collection and community participation in maintaining hygiene.

Community Impact

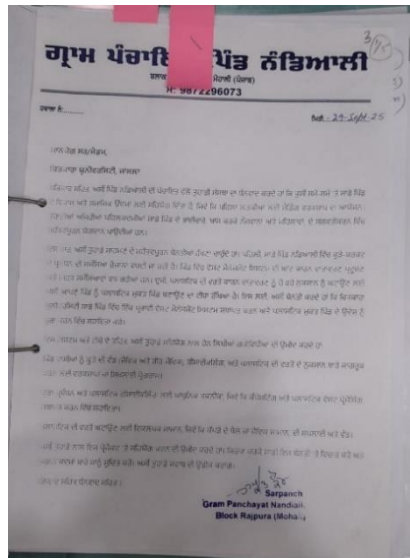
