Key SDGs Mapped in the Curriculum:

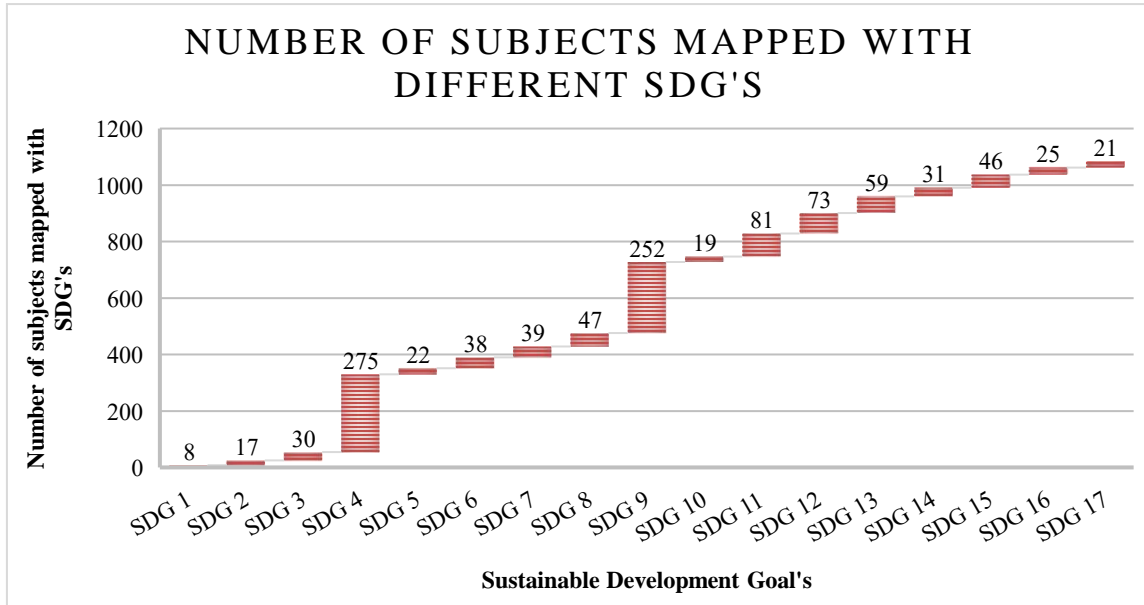
