Widely regarded as one of the most prestigious championships in global table tennis, the event features the world's leading nations and elite athletes.

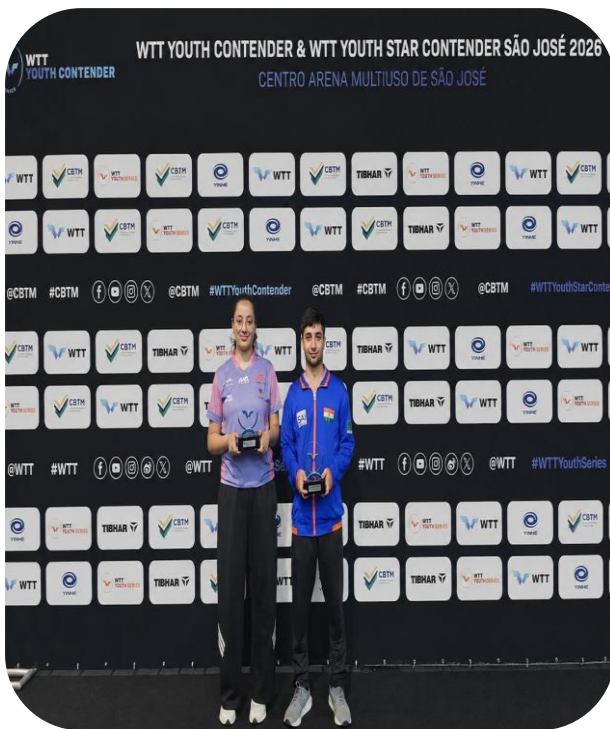
