The Centre of Excellence for Sustainability was formed under Office Order in Jan 2024. Our team of eight passionate environmentalists joined hands and got our brain and mind ticking, as to how we could contribute to our roles. Numerous initiatives were already being undertaken by the various schools/ colleges and departments of the campus; but there was so much yet to be done (there would always be room for improvement and room for more activities!).

We designed a route, wherein we could touch base with all teams and move ahead, one step at a time, but together. Offline and online meetings and discussions gave us some light on how to take the next step.

There are four principles that we would follow -

The first two principles - "What gets measured gets managed" & "Unless you know what assets you have, you cannot decide what to procure further".

For both of these, data is a must, and so is data analysis.

The second two principles - " maximise students' participation in all activities" and to spread awareness, as much as possible. This way, we provide more chances of creating leaders who appreciate the responsibility of "leaving no one behind". For the second principle too we needed to know what was done till now... so we required data!!

Hence, we decided to prioritise data and started off with data collection. The results were overwhelming. We had more than 2900 events in the various SDGs and high involvement in Research papers, Collaborations, Patents etc., too related to sustainability. For certain departments, we suggested digitalisation of data and for most others, we suggested zooming into goals and achieving milestones. This way, we could analyse the performance and progress too. Our first step was the digitalisation of demands for plantation drives and green gifts, in coordination with the department of Horticulture and the Chalkpad Team. Further, we coordinated with all schools/colleges and departments for various activities related to sustainability.


Empowering Sustainable Futures: One-Week Management Development Program on Green Products at Chitkara University | 05.02.2024 to 12.02.2024
