These activities not only raise awareness about social responsibilities but also equip participants with the knowledge and skills to contribute meaningfully to a fair and peaceful society.

- 4. Gender Sensitization Course:** Conducted by Chitkara School of Maritime Studies, this course addressed gender equality within the maritime industry, fostering awareness among cadets about inclusivity, preventing harassment, and meeting legal requirements on gender-related issues. The course aimed to create an inclusive and respectful maritime environment where all genders can work without discrimination.

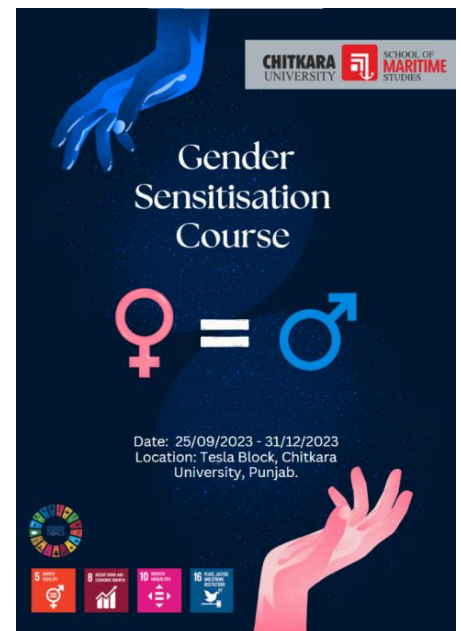

A total of 53 (fifty-three) teams across eight states have taken part in the north-zone competition. Overall, it was a wonderful and learning experience for all the students.

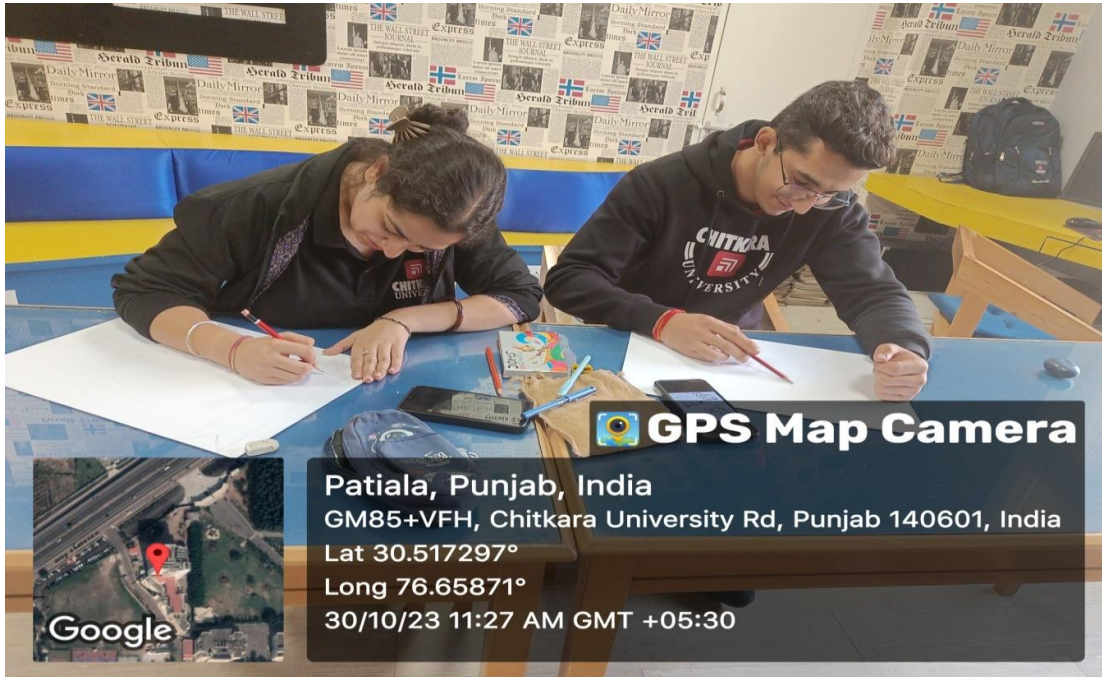

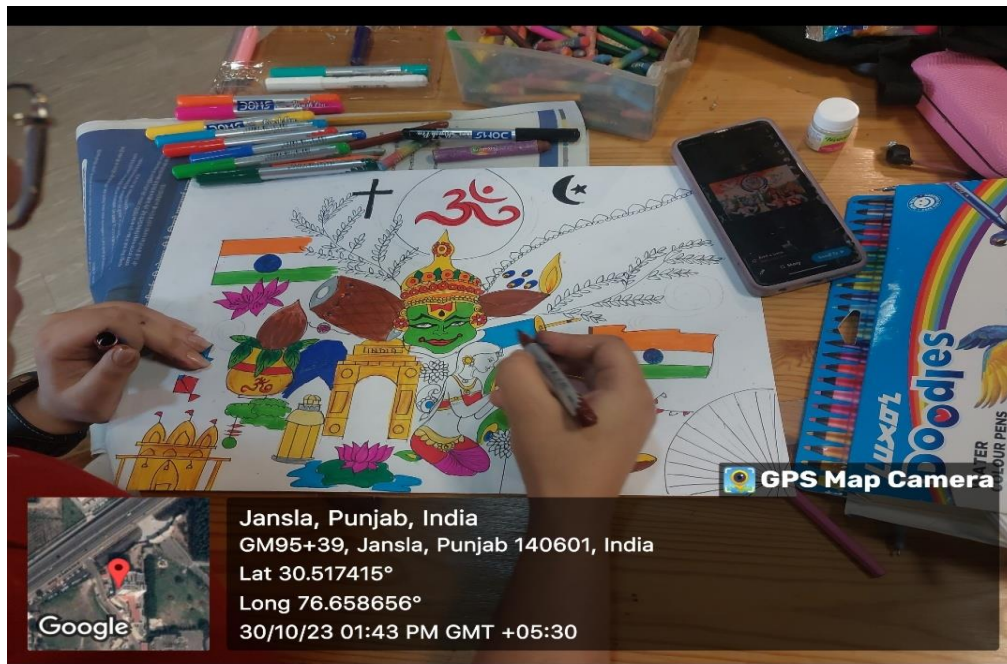
### **Description of Event: -**

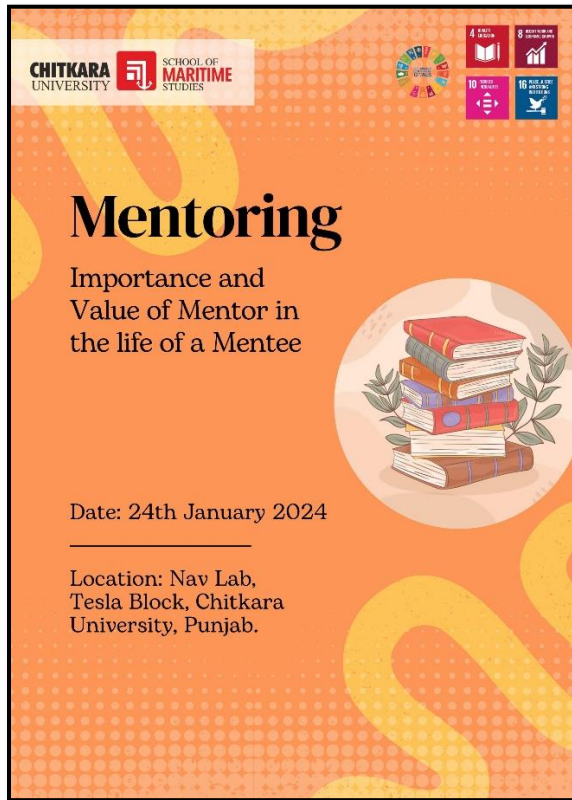

### **About the Activity: -**

Chitkara Business School has organized an insightful event on “Corporate Ethos” conducted by Ms. Geetika Tiwari, a corporate expert. Students of Integrated Programme in Management Batch 2021 and 2022 got the learnings about corporate life. Ms. Geetika told about the core values, culture and beliefs of an organization and its impact on working performance. Another learning we got about the ‘Professionalism at Workplace’ and what is professionalism. Professionalism includes attire, code of conduct, way of talking, behavior, performance, actions on the floor. Learnings are about ‘Characteristics and Behavior of Professionals’ and about ‘Etiquette and Communication Skills’ is discussed where she talked about being calm and always go in right direction to deal with any misconduct. It is okay to speak in Hindi with colleagues and mostly we use Hindi while communicating but the choice of our words does matter. Ms. Geetika also talked about the POSH act (prevention of sexual harassment at workplace) and companies. It was introduced in 2013, initially for women but gradually it became for both men and women. It includes two parts, verbal sexual harassment and non-verbal sexual harassment, which includes touch and looking at someone. It involves protection against sexual harassment to all women, irrespective of their employment status (employed, contract worker, intern, etc.), Expanded Coverage which focused on women's safety, the POSH Act has been evolving to include men as well and Complaint Mechanism which mandates the formation of an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) within organizations to investigate complaints of sexual harassment and recommend appropriate action.

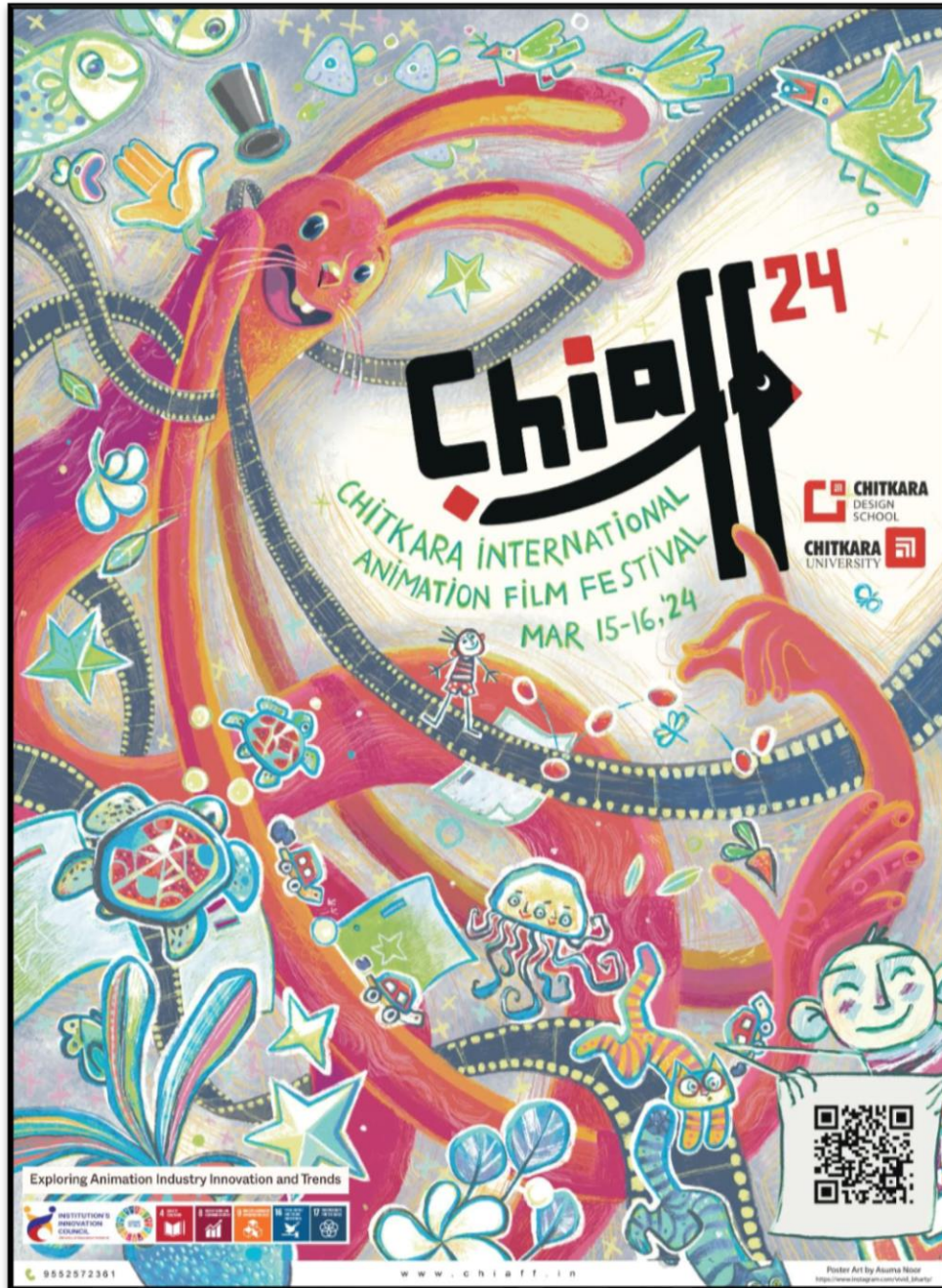
### **About the Activity:** -

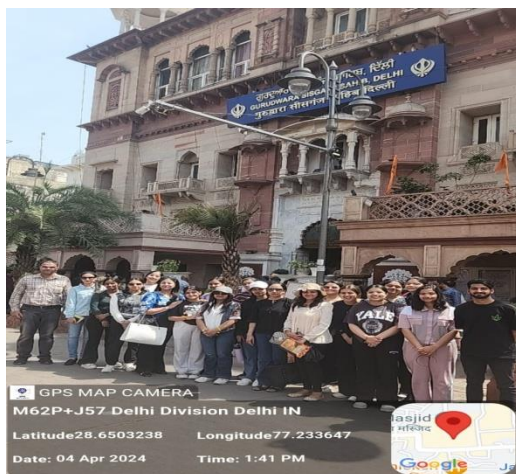
