



About the activity

A total of sixty students from different departments opted for various programs spearheaded by the Office of International Affairs. The Short Mobility summer school programs are always meant to be a transformative and memorable experience with a lasting impression. Students returned home with new friendships, unforgettable memories, and a renewed sense of curiosity and openness to the world. This academic year, the International Summer School by the University of Nottingham, Malaysia campus, stretching from July 3rd to 19th was a two-week summer school focusing primarily on the student's openness to discovering new things, adjusting to other surroundings, and getting involved with international issues. This allowed the students to make their resumes look stronger and become more competitive when looking for a job or applying for graduate school. A total of 20 students from different departments and disciplines participated in this summer school, The University of British Columbia organized a month-long international summer program from June 14th to July 17th, 2023. Five students from different programs at our university participated in the given UBC- VSP where the major highlights were living on the UBC Vancouver campus in the modern student residences, with an opportunity to study two uniquely designed courses taught by world-class UBC instructors. Two students from the Computer Science and Engineering, and Computer Applications department availed this summer school opportunity called the ICT Summer School 2023. The majority of courses in this program were engineering-related, but some included transdisciplinary subjects like business and communication to accommodate students from a variety of academic backgrounds. The course emphasized experiential learning through case studies, group projects, and practical exercises. Five students from the Computer Science and Engineering Department also went for a short-term mobility program at Deakin University, Australia.

A total of eleven students from different departments opted for the Credit Transfer Articulation program Four students articulated their degrees at Deakin University, Australia, one student at York University, Canada, three at the University of Manitoba, one at South Dakota State University, USA and two in University of Prince Edward Island, Canada.

12 students from different departments took the Internship program in Taiwan, Italy, Germany, and New Zealand in a virtual mode. The Taiwan Experience Education Program (TEEP) is an initiative by the Taiwanese government aimed at promoting international exchanges and cooperation in education. Six students from the Computer Science and Engineering department were selected for this esteemed internship opportunity. TEEP provided scholarships and funding to support the participants during their educational experience in Taiwan. These financial







incentives can help the students to cover tuition fees, living expenses, travel costs, and other related expenses.

Three students from the Computer Science and Engineering department went for a Semester Exchange program at Fontys University of Applied Sciences, Netherlands and two students from the School of Architecture and Planning opted for a semester exchange program at La Salle Ramon Llull University, Spain, and University of Alicante, Spain respectively.

By opting for such opportunities, our students had the opportunity to study globally relevant courses from world-class faculty Through such programs, students were exposed to peers and instructors from different parts of the world which also gave them insights into diverse viewpoints and perspectives on global issues. This helped them broaden their understanding of complex issues and encouraged critical thinking and intercultural dialogue. By participating in exchange programs individuals can contribute to the advancement of their careers while also promoting economic development and productive employment for all.

About the Activity

A Building evacuation drill was held within the different blocks of Chitkara University to check the response of faculty in case of fire and any other disasters. Four teams made for this mock-up practice were firefighting, search and rescue, Quick Response Team (Q.R.T.), and Medical Team. Each Building faculty member and their staff participated in this mock-up drill and also taught rescue techniques and basic firefighting.

SDG 3, Fires are a leading cause of unintentional injuries and fatalities. Training in fire prevention, escape plans, and extinguisher use equips people to respond safely, minimizing casualties. Smoke inhalation from fires can cause respiratory problems like asthma and lung disease. Fire safety measures like proper ventilation and fire drills reduce smoke exposure, promoting better health. SDG 8, Fire safety training creates safer working environments, reducing lost workdays due to fire-related injuries and illnesses. This benefits both employees and businesses promoting sustained inclusive and sustainable economic growth. SDG 11, Fires can damage buildings, roads, and other infrastructure. Fire safety practices like proper construction codes and fire prevention plans minimize such damage, leading to more sustainable and resilient communities. SDG 13, Large fires release significant amounts of carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases. By preventing fires, we can mitigate climate change and its associated impacts.

To provide BE- ME batch 2021 students with practical exposure to industrial processes and operations . To enhance students 'understanding of occupational safety threats and practices in a real- world setting .

To familiarize students with the manufacturing process of single - door refrigerators at Godrej & Boyce Mfg . Co. Ltd . To facilitate interaction with industry professionals and gain insights into the application of engineering concepts in manufacturing .

Description

On September 15, 2023, a notable industrial visit was organized for the BE- ME batch 2021 students to Godrej & Boyce Mfg . Co. Ltd . in Mohali , marking a valuable educational opportunity for 28 enthusiastic participants . Coordinated by Mr. Mohit Bhayana and Mr. Nand Lal, the visit was meticulously planned to offer insightful exposure to industrial processes and occupational safety practices. The program commenced with a captivating presentation by the safety officer, who illuminated the threats to occupational safety through a visually engaging PPT. This served as a foundational understanding for the students, setting the stage for the immersive experience ahead. Guided by Mr. Sanjay, the Plant Head, the students embarked on a comprehensive tour of the single - door refrigerator manufacturing plant . Every step of the manufacturing process was meticulously explained and demonstrated, providing invaluable insights into the intricate workings of industrial production. Topics covered ranged from the composition of materials like HIPS (High Impact Polystyrene) used in components, to the foaming section, final assembly area, and testing stations. The visit culminated in an interactive session at various testing stations, where students witnessed firsthand the rigorous quality checks and inspections conducted to ensure the efficiency and safety of the products. This practical exposure deepened their understanding of industrial processes and quality standards.

The event featured an engaging Q&A session, allowing participants to interact directly with Mr. Nashi. This facilitated a deeper understanding of individual







It includes two parts: verbal sexual harassment and non-verbal sexual harassment, which includes touching and looking at someone. It involves protection against sexual harassment to all women, irrespective of their employment status (employed, contract worker, intern, etc.), expanded coverage, which







focused on women's safety; the POSH Act has been evolving to include men as well; and a complaint mechanism, which mandates the formation of an internal complaints committee (ICC) within organizations to investigate complaints of sexual harassment and recommend appropriate action.

The India Immersion Program "Doing Business in India" offered a comprehensive and intensive learning experience for students from Mondragon University, Spain, during their week-long visit. Designed to equip them with the knowledge and understanding to navigate the intricacies of the Indian business landscape, the program covered a diverse range of topics. The program provided an in-depth exploration of the Indian economy, including market entry strategies, foreign investment regulations, and the Goods and Services Tax (GST) structure. Experts unpacked the unique aspects of Indian business culture, including negotiation styles and







leadership approaches, drawing comparisons with European practices. Sessions explored high-growth sectors in India, such as healthcare and information technology (IT) contributing to the achievement of SDG 8 which emphasizes the need for decent work and economic growth.

Students gained valuable insights into startup ecosystems and business models for sustainable growth, with case studies showcasing successful Indian ventures. A visit to Mahindra Swaraj Tractors provided firsthand exposure to a leading Indian manufacturing company's operations. Beyond academic sessions, the program incorporated cultural activities to broaden the students' understanding of India. Students participated in creating Rangoli designs, tying turbans, and draping sarees. Visits to the Golden Temple in Amritsar and Shimla offered a glimpse into India's rich heritage and diverse landscapes. The program culminated in student presentations where they showcased their learnings by creating a business manual comparing shoe sole production in two Indian cities. This final project allowed them to synthesize the knowledge gained throughout the week and demonstrate their critical thinking skills. The program's success was further solidified by the positive feedback from students and the expressed interest in future collaborations between Mondragon University and Chitkara University.

Day wise report

On Day 1, 6th May 2024, representatives from Chitkara Business School including Dr. Sandhir Sharma, Dr. Sanjeev Sahni, and Dr. Rashmi Aggarwal welcomed delegates, Prof. Xabier Romano and student ambassadors from Mondragon University, Spain. After introductions and a talk on Chitkara University's history and goals, faculty members Dr. Neeraj Anand and Dr. Subodh Saluja presented insights on "Doing Business in India." The event also included cultural activities like Rangoli making, turban tying, and saree draping, led by Dr. Sovia Singh, along with presentations and gift-giving.

On Day 2, 7th May 2024, Dr. Neeraj Anand kicked things off with a session on "Introduction to Business in Asia," exploring opportunities and challenges with a focus on the Indian market.







A knowledge-testing quiz followed. The afternoon brought Dr. Subodh Saluja and Dr. Prachi Gupta, who delved into "Asian Leadership and Management Styles" and business innovation in India, respectively. Finally, Dr. Adarsh Agarwal discussed the "Indian Startup Ecosystem" with students participating in an activity to generate their innovative business ideas.

Day 3, 8th May 2024, began with Dr. Subodh Saluja exploring Indian business culture through communication styles and the Mumbai Dabbawalas case study. Dr. Shuchi Dawra followed up by examining the impact of culture on business using Hofstede's dimensions. The focus then shifted to globalization with Dr. Neeraj Anand's session on "Globalization of Asian Firms" featuring case studies of Indian and Asian companies. Dr. Rashmi Aggarwal concluded the day's lectures by highlighting the rise of fintech in Asia, particularly India, using a WeChat case study. Students participated in a quiz to test their understanding, and the afternoon featured fun outdoor activities showcasing the campus's sports facilities, including table tennis, badminton, and swimming.

On Day 4, 9th May 2024, Dr. Neeraj Anand kicked off with a session on navigating market entry and investment in India, including key considerations, entry strategies, and company registration using a Foxconn case study. The afternoon focused on Asian business opportunities, with Dr. Subodh Saluja exploring tech innovation, retail trends, and growth drivers like Xiaomi and Alibaba. Dr. Keerti then highlighted medical sector opportunities in India, encompassing medical tourism, home healthcare, and telemedicine, along with the Ayushman Bharat scheme. The day concluded with Mr. Manav Bansal, Chief Happiness Officer, leading an engaging session on the "science of wellbeing."

Day 5, 10th May 2024, began with Dr. Neeraj Anand outlining legal considerations for foreign businesses in India, followed by a student potential exploration activity. Patent filing procedures







were covered by Dr. Panda next. The afternoon shifted focus to Indo-Spanish business partnerships, with Dr. Subodh Saluja exploring opportunities, challenges, and case studies of successful collaborations. Students tested their knowledge of the Indian business environment through a quiz. The day concluded with Dr. Sovia Raj's exploration of regional civilizations and cultures, highlighting India's contributions to science, culture, medicine, and more.

Day 6 & 7, 11th & 12th May 2024, Following their academic program, students from Mondragon University embarked on a cultural excursion on May 11th, visiting the Golden Temple in Amritsar. On May 12th, they traveled to Shimla to experience the city's unique offerings.

Day 8, 13th May 2024, wrapped up the academic program with Dr. Subodh Saluja's session on effective business negotiation in India, followed by Colonel Bikram Ahluwalia's talk on nonnegotiable leadership using the Indian Armed Forces as an example. Dr. Neeraj Anand then shifted the focus to India's attractiveness as a business destination, citing examples of Spanish entrepreneurs in India. The day concluded with Dr. Dhiresh Kulshrestha's presentation comparing the Indian and Spanish economies, including a discussion on economic diversification and structural transformation.

Day 9, 14th May 2024, focused on Indian business landscapes. Dr. Subodh Saluja opened the day with a session on attractive business clusters, highlighting locations like Bengaluru's IT hub and Hyderabad's pharmaceutical industry. Dr. Neeraj Anand followed by presenting successful startup strategies in India, including key growth sectors, business models, and case studies of Byju's, IKEA, TaxiBot, Delta Airlines, and others. Prashant Singh from CEED concluded the day by showcasing the Chitkara University startup ecosystem, featuring incubated startups like CustoShoe and Kala Coach.







Day 10, 15th May 2024, delved into startup business models. Dr. Subodh opened with examples like Google Drive, Spotify, Uber, and Airbnb, while Dr. Gautam Bansal provided a broader understanding of different business model types. Students then took center stage, leading a panel discussion on contrasting Indian and European business leadership styles, before creating and presenting their business model canvases.

On Day 11, 16th May 2024, students visited Mahindra Swaraj Tractors for a firsthand look at tractor part manufacturing, assembly, and quality testing. The tour included the shop floor, showcasing production and quality control procedures. Company representatives provided an introduction to Mahindra Swaraj Tractors, its products, history, and objectives, followed by an interactive session.

Day 12, 17th May 2024, marked the culmination of the "Doing Business in Asia/India" program. Students divided into 6 cohorts presented a business manual comparing shoe sole production in Surat and Ahmedabad. 




